### COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY What are your thoughts?

#### **What is CIL and how is it allocated?**

The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) allows Waverley Borough Council to raise funds, from some forms of new development, to help fund the infrastructure needed to mitigate the impacts of new development. 15% of funds collected are passed to the Parish in question, to be spent on infrastructure required in a community where development took place. In the case of a Parish that has a Neighbourhood Plan, such as Ewhurst, 25% of CIL funds are allocated to the Parish.

#### **How can it be spent?**

- The provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure  
or
- Anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places on Ewhurst and Ellens Green

#### **What is not eligible:**

- Projects that have been completed prior to an application being submitted
- Projects that require ongoing revenue expenditure
- Annual maintenance or repair
- Projects promoting a political party
- Projects that conflict with existing Parish Council policies
- VAT that you can recover

Ewhurst Parish Council would like your help in two ways: Firstly, to score the projects that we have identified as fitting the criteria set out above, secondly to nominate projects that you believe would bring benefit to the Parish.
