WA/2025/00326 Cherry Tree Cottage, Shere Road

Certificate of Lawfulness under Section 192 for installation of 2 rooflights. Members noted that this application had been granted.

NMA/2025/00249 1 Mapledrakes Road

WA/2023/01416 – Alteration of rear extension roof from hip to gable, with French doors at rear. Members noted that this application had been granted.

6. Appeal

APP/R3650/W/25/3359896 – Land at Pennings, Plough Lane

Erection of a detached dwelling with associated parking and amenity space. Members agreed to repeat former objections to this application, whilst noting that neighbours had withdrawn their objections.

APP/R650/W/25/3360774 - Brookhurst Grange, Holmbury Road, Cranleigh

Change of Use of barn to mixed agricultural and equestrian use. Members agreed to repeat former objections to this application.

WA/2024/00030 – Land to the North of Maybanks, Cox Green Road, Rudgwick, Horsham, Surrey RH12 3AA The development proposed is the construction of three terraced courtyard dwellings with associated gardens, hardstanding and car parking; altered garden arrangement for Turnpike. Allowed.

7. Chairman's report

Upper House: granted. The Parish Council had no objection but had asked the Tree Officer to inspect the adjacent Oak.

13 Hermongers Lane: granted.

Land adjacent to Stillington: Cllrs Henry and Bloomfield had undertaken a walk by, but had not sent comments as they were not quorate.

Works to Trees:

Greenside:no objectionBostocks Close:To pursue a TPO on all trees on this siteCricket green:granted

Cllr J Bloomfield raised concerns about the works at Barn Cottage, on the Green, where the ditch had again been filled in. Condition 5 of their planning approval required details of the design of services to be approved by the local planning authority, and there was nothing on the website to confirm that this had been done. The Clerk confirmed that she had alerted WBC's Countryside Ranger to this work and he had said that he would investigate.

Cllr Henry observed that the contractor's vehicles were parked on the verges at the Green. Cllr Higgins advised that the Enforcement Officer had written to them to ask them to stop parking their vehicles there.
